1. Version Information

This release of Intermec Browser operates on CV61 vehicle mount computers running XP/Win7. Please reference the Intermec Browser User's Manual for additional information on features and use of Intermec Browser.

2. Installation Notes

To Install Intermec Browser

The download posted on the website is a SmartSystems Bundle. The installation will install into a SmartSystems Console to allow for easy "drag-and-drop" installation onto your discovered devices. You may also install Intermec Browser via other methods such as a USB drive.

Note: IB_XP_Win7_1.20.05.xxxx will install Intermec Browser based on the Internet Explorer 6 (IE6) engine. Installing a newer version of Internet Explorer may result in the engine being upgraded.

Licensing

Intermec Browser V1.20 may require an activation or maintenance license to operate in full featured mode.

- If maintenance has not been purchased, a new license may be required to run this version of Intermec Browser.

Intermec Browser will run in a Demo mode for 60 days if your device does not contain a proper factory license or activation license or maintenance license. Demo mode allows you to operate the device for 60 days in "full feature". After 60 days, the device will move to nag mode.

3. New Functionality Available in Version 1.20

- User Interface has been revamped.
- User Interface is more configurable via Intermec Settings.
- Basic sample application has been upgraded.
- Configuration via ib.ini file is no longer functional. For devices where the ib.ini file was officially supported: If an ib.ini file is present during installation the settings will be read and stored at that point in time.

Additional Notes

- ITCAXEdit control only works on Windows Mobile 5.0 (or later) devices. Currently not supported for CV61
- UUID is not supported on the CV61.
- Battery indicator is not supported on the CV61.
- Due to Windows 7 security features "IB_UpdateIni" will only function when Intermec Browser is run as administrator.

4. Issues Fixed In This Version

- None.

5. Known Issues

- IB_GetBluetoothScannerInfo does not return scanner info if one of the following conditions is true: EA30, CK3, Wedge Mode Enabled.
- Starting Browser with network checking enabled on a CV41 WES results in an exception error if the network interfaces are all disabled.
