

## ***Important TE 2000 Information!***

---

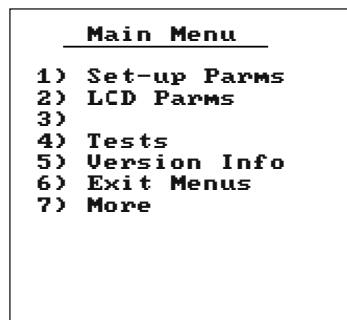
Using Intermec's TE 2000™ terminal emulation application, you can choose to run any emulation (5250, VT/ANSI, 3270). 3270 is the default emulation that is running on your terminal, which may be different than the emulation you ordered. However, your terminal will have an emulation-specific keypad overlay. To change the emulation, follow the procedure in this instruction sheet.

**VT/ANSI (TE 2000 v6.11 or earlier)** If your Trakker Antares® terminal has a scanner, the scanner is disabled until you connect to a host. For help configuring the terminal so that it will connect to a host, see your Trakker Antares terminal getting started guide.

**5250 or 3270** If your Trakker Antares terminal has a scanner, the scanner is disabled until you enable the scanner to scan all fields. For help enabling the scanner to scan all fields, follow the procedure in this instruction sheet.

### **To change to a different emulation and to enable the scanner to scan all fields**

1. On your terminal, press   to access the TE menu. On the 2415 with the 37-key keypad, press  . The Main Menu appears.

2. Press . The Enter Password prompt appears.
3. Type        and press . The Set-up ParmS menu appears.
4. Press . The Protocol Opts menu appears.
5. Press . The Data Stream menu appears.
6. To run 3270 terminal emulation, press .
- To run 5250 terminal emulation, press .
- To run VT/ANSI terminal emulation, press .

(over)

7. Configure the terminal to scan all fields.  
(5250)
  - a. Press . You return to the Protocol Opts menu.
  - b. Press . The 5250 menu appears.
  - c. Press . A dark box appears around the Scan All Flds option that indicates that this option is enabled.
- (3270)
  - a. Press . You return to the Protocol Opts menu.
  - b. Press . The 3270 menu appears.
  - c. Press  to access more menus.
  - d. Press . A dark box appears around the Scan All Flds option that indicates that this option is enabled.
8. Press  until the Set-up Parm's menu appears.
9. Press  to access more menus.
10. Press  to save your changes. The Enter Password prompt appears.
11. Type        and press . You return to the Set-Up Parm's menu.
12. Press  to exit the TE menu.
